## Abstract Content Checklist

✓	The abstract should cover <b>all</b> elements shown in the <b>NHRC Abstract Format</b> .
✓	The abstract should fit within the themes of (i) COVID-19 Areas (Vaccines, Laboratory Technology, Maternal Health, National Security, Mental Health, Epidemiology), (ii) Non Communicable Diseases (NCDs), (iii) Health Economics, (iv) Gender Based Violence and (v) Public Health Advances. <b>However, abstracts of other high quality research will be accepted.</b>
✓	The research should be of scientific merit.
✓	<b>The research should be of relevance to the Jamaica and or global health sectors, and should ideally be able to inform health policy and practice.</b>
✓	<b>Abstracts should be no more than 250 words.</b>
✓	<i>The abstract should include aims/objectives, methods, results and conclusions, with each section clearly delineated.</i>
✓	The abstract should describe the content of the paper. It should properly introduce the topic, describe the body, and comment on the conclusions reached.
✓	The abstract should be coherent and grammatically sound.
✓	The Title of the paper should reflect the content of the abstract.
✓	The Aim(s) should be clearly stated and the study should adequately answer the objectives of the study.
✓	The Methods should be adequate to answer the stated objectives. This section should also describe statistical methods used.
✓	The Results should be in line with stated objectives and include the outcomes of the appropriate statistical tests.
✓	The Conclusion should be drawn from the results presented.

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
