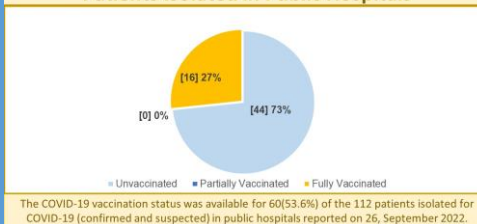

- 96.7 % Unvaccinated**
