**Background:** Hurricane Melissa, a Category 5 hurricane, made landfall in Jamaica on 28 October 2025, causing extensive damage to health infrastructure across several parishes, particularly in St. Elizabeth, Westmoreland, St. James, and Trelawny. Despite early preparedness measures by the Ministry of Health and Wellness (MOHW), the impact significantly disrupted primary, secondary, and tertiary health services.

In response, the MOHW developed the Hurricane Melissa Response Programme (HMRP), aimed at restoring health services, strengthening system resilience, and mitigating post-disaster health risks through a phased recovery approach.

**Role Summary:** The Procurement Officer will be required to provide technical procurement support to the Procurement Specialist in the execution of procurement activities under the programme, ensuring that all procurement processes are executed in a timely manner and in compliance with Government of Jamaica procurement laws and donor agency procurement guidelines while maintaining efficiency, transparency, and value for money

**Eligibility:** A valid **Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)** or Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) is required at the deadline date for Bid Submission.

**Procurement Method:** Bidding will be conducted through **Open National Competition** procedures as specified by the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Procurement Act, 2015 as amended & Public Procurement Regulations, 2018 as amended.
