Project Name: Rehabilitation of Savanna-Lar-Mar Hospital

Background: Hurricane Melissa, a Category 5 hurricane, made landfall in Jamaica on 28 October 2025, causing extensive damage to health infrastructure across several parishes, particularly in St. Elizabeth, Westmoreland, Hanover, St. James, and Trelawny. Despite early preparedness measures by the Ministry of Health and Wellness (MOHW), the impact significantly disrupted primary, secondary, and tertiary health services.

In response, the MOHW developed the Hurricane Melissa Response Programme (HMRP), aimed at restoring health services, strengthening system resilience, and mitigating post-disaster health risks through a phased recovery approach.

Role Summary: Review and validate existing A&E design drawings;
Develop outstanding drawings for:

- Outpatient Department (OPD);
- Physiotherapy areas; and
- Associated clinical and support spaces

Ensure full multidisciplinary coordination;
Prepare costed and unpriced Bills of Quantities; and
Deliver a complete tender-ready design package

Eligibility: Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) or proof of tax compliance within the last 12 months.

Procurement Method: Bidding will be conducted through **National Competitive Bidding (NCB)** procedures as specified by the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Procurement Act, 2015 (as amended) & Public Procurement Regulations, 2018 (as amended).
