JOB PURPOSE

Under the direct supervision of the Director, Standards, Research and Development the Development Officer- New Technology/Complementary Health Services is responsible to develop, implement and monitor, policies, standards and programs for emerging health technologies and complimentary health services, ensuring safe and effective integration into Jamaica's public health system and supporting evidence-based improvements in healthcare delivery.

KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS

1. Contributes to the formulation and review of national policies, strategies, and guidelines governing new technologies and complementary health services to ensure alignment with national priorities and international best practices.
2. Assists in developing and maintaining standards, norms, and regulatory mechanisms to guide the safe delivery and integration of complementary and emerging health services.
3. Conducts and supports research, environmental scans, and policy analyses to inform decision-making and strengthen the evidence base for complementary and alternative medicine and emerging technologies.
4. Supports the design, coordination, and monitoring of programmes aimed at improving healthcare delivery through the integration of new technologies and complementary services.
5. Collects, analyses, and interprets programme data, including adverse event reports, to identify trends, assess impact, and inform continuous improvement.
6. Liaises with regulatory bodies, practitioners, and internal stakeholders to support implementation, compliance, and continuous improvement of standards and programmes.
